	Set and work toward enrollment and attendance goals.

	Enlist a leader who is coordinating and encouraging outreach efforts to youth.

	Develop, maintain, and use a prospect file.	
	Participate in and encourage youth to participate in regularly scheduled outreach visitation.

	Participate in our Sunday School's preparation event or conduct our own preparation to begin the Sunday School year	
	Study the Bible as our textbook and use Youth Sunday School literature published by the Baptist Sunday School Board	l
	Provide the best learning environment possible.	
	Provide at least one special Bible study opportunity at a time other than Sunday morning.	
	Encourage youth to bring their Bibles to Sunday School and learn to use them in Bible study.	
	Practice total period teaching by providing one hour for Bible study each week.	
	Care for Youth and Their Families	
	Maintain and use records and information on youth and family members, including ministry needs.	
	In addition to one youth care leader for up to every four youth enrolled, enlist and train one youth class leader.	
	Pray regularly for youth and their families.	
	Provide or participate in ministry training.	
	Plan and implement actions to involve youth and workers in ministering to members, prospects, and families of youth	ı
	Conduct at least one parent-worker meeting each year.

	Participate in or provide evangelism training.

	Enroll unsaved youth and encourage their participation in Bible study.

	☐ Enlist Christian youth to join you in witnessing to unsaved youth and winning them to Christ.	
	☐ Promote, support, and conduct some form of Bible study to reach unsaved youth.	
	☐ Pray for parents, family members, and youth who have not yet made a profession of faith.
